





| <b>B</b> | <br>Blood to blood & sexual contact | <br>Yes  | <br>No cure (treatment available)                      | <br>1 to 4 months incubation<br>Most adult patients clear infection (~90%) |  |
| <b>C</b> | <br>Blood to blood                | <br>No | <br>Curable (8-12 week treatment)                    | <br>2 weeks to 6 months incubation                                       |  |
