

## Patient Room Entry/Exit Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

### I. Protocol for entering room:

- A. N-95 respirator
- B. Perform hand hygiene
- C. Gown
- D. Protective eyewear
  - 1. Mask with face shield (over N-95 respirator) OR
  - 2. Goggles
- E. Surgical hood (optional)
- F. Surgical booties (optional)
- G. Gloves

### II. Protocol for exiting room:

- A. Remove gloves by peeling inside-out
- B. Perform hand hygiene
- C. Remove hood (if worn)
- D. Remove face shield (if worn)
- E. Remove goggles (place in holding container with disinfectant)
- F. Remove gown with inside outward, pulling from the top downward
- G. Perform hand hygiene
- H. Remove N-95/Respirator
- I. Perform hand hygiene

**I. Protocol for entering room:**

- A. N-95 respirator

**II. Protocol for exiting room:**

- A. At door prior to exiting:
  - 1. Remove gloves by peeling inside-out
  - 2. Remove gown with inside outward, pulling from the top downward
  - 3. Perform hand hygiene
- B. At door just outside of room:
  - 1. Remove hood (if worn)
  - 2. Remove face shield (if worn)
  - 3. Remove goggles
  - 4. Remove N-95
  - 5. Perform hand hygiene
  - 6. Decontaminate goggles by wiping exterior surface with alcohol or vesphene
  - 7. Perform hand hygiene
